

Parish Council Summary 10th March Meeting update

New Councillor Appointment

I'm sure you will all be pleased to know that the appointment of a new councillor was much more straight forward than the recent BBC series Casual Vacancy.

We had four very high quality applicants. Each gave a brief presentation about themselves and their reasons for wanting to become a councillor.

The vote was very close with a tie in the first round and Keron Taylor winning the second round by a single vote. We would like to welcome Keron to the council.

The other applicants were Diane Christie-Rundle, Mike Germany and Terry Mundy. We hope they all reapply as positions become available.

Military

As you have probably noticed there is increased military activity on the Plain at the moment with live firing into the Warminster area in addition to the central area. There have been increased reports of dog walkers crossing fences into the live firing area which is causing concern.

There were also reports of military vehicles using Water Lane. This area is out of bounds and our liaison officer has requested that the registration number of any vehicle should be reported and those involved will be disciplined.

Wiltshire Council

Cllr Howard provided an update on Wiltshire Council matters that affect us, including the introduction of a £40 annual charge for the collection of garden waste from green wheelie bins.

COUNCIL TAX - ENFORD PARISH COUNCIL

You may have noticed on your Council Tax Bill for 2015/16 the Enford Parish Council charge has increased by 51.4% although the overall difference compared to the previous years is only 1.0%. The charge for Enford is considerably lower than the average for Town and Parish Councils and whilst it fluctuates each year, depending on any monies carried forward, it usually sits within a £5k to £8k band. This is demonstrated by the fact that the charge for 2015 is actually 14.3% lower than in 2010, last years was also lower than the previous year by 25.7%.

The Precept (the money we demand from Wiltshire Council) for Enford is used to ensure the basic amenities of the Parish are properly maintained for the good of the village, donations are also given to a number of local organisations including the Youth Club and Football Club.
