# Dr Peter Jenkins Is Retiring From General Practice

I will be retiring from Avon Valley Practice on 30 June 2015. I've thoroughly enjoyed my 40 years as a GP and will take my clinical expertise with me as I help shape health services for the whole of Wiltshire in my new role as Chair of Wiltshire Clinical Commissioning Group. To say farewell, I would like to invite you to afternoon tea on Monday 29 June from 1330 to 1600 at Upavon Surgery. Please RSVP to avonvalley.practice@nhs.net by 22 June.'

#### What will happen next at Avon Valley Practice?

We will be working closely with four neighbouring surgeries in Shrewton, Codford, Wilton and Fovant (known as The Orchard Partnership) to manage primary care services in the local area. Each surgery is small, offering care to 3,000 patients or less at a local level. To help small practices like us to continue to provide primary care to local people we need the strength that comes from working collaboratively with other similar sized practices in the area. From a patient point of view you will not see any change to the level of service that you receive and you will still be able to see a doctor at your usual practice.

#### How will this affect me?

Dr Fiona Ross Russell, Dr Ian Green and Dr Edward Millar-Craig together with our nursing team will continue to provide your primary care needs. Alongside them, our team of receptionists, dispensers and administrators will continue to support them. The day to day running of Avon Valley practice and those in The Orchard Partnership will not change and you can still expect to see familiar faces when you come for your appointment.

#### ENFORD COMMUNITY FUND

A number of requests were considered by the committee at the March round of funding and the following awards were made:

The sum of £200 was promised to the organisational team of the World War One Commemoration that is to take place later in the year, enabling them to provide some free entertainments for children in the afternoon. The sum of up to £800 was promised to the Youth Club to help fund their trip to Oxenwood outdoors centre in July. This is a fantastic opportunity for children to take part in activities that they might otherwise miss out on because of the expense. Finally, the sum of £160 was awarded to the Parish Council to help fund a new notice board for the village. The old one is now very fragile and has come to the end of its life .

The Enford Community Fund comprises all the profits from the fete and fireworks events and is there to help community projects within the Parish of Enford comprising Enford, East and West Chisenbury, Coombe, Compton, Fifield, Littlecott, Longstreet and New Town. So if you run or are considering setting up a project and might need help with initial costs or equipment, please get in touch.

Applications for awards must be made to the treasurer – Amanda Farrow – by email or letter no later than the first day of the award month (March & September). amanda.farrow@chisenbury.co.uk or 537 East Chisenbury.

The following guidelines will be followed in allocating funds

- 1. Awards will be considered every 6 months in March and September
- 2. Awards will be made for individual projects and are not designed to allow awardees to become reliant on the award on an annual/regular basis
- Awards will be made to causes that benefit the community and not specific individuals
- 4. No awards will be made for greater than £1000
- 5. For any award to be granted there must be agreement by at least 75% of the funding committee


