NEWSFLASH: WILTSHIRE COUNCIL UNABLE TO FUND PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY (PROW) MAINTENANCE 2016

URGENTLY WANTED

WILLING ENFORD PARISH PROW WORKING GROUP VOLUNTEERS

AIM: To form a Parish PROW Volunteer Work Group to support Wiltshire Council Community Engagement Manager and PROW Maintenance Team in clearing bridle paths/byways or in making improvements across the parish. You will need to be prepared to attend initial planning meeting with Marc Read, undertake Health and Safety training as well as dedicate time to preserving access to official bridleways, paths & tracks.

SOLAR FARM COOMBE

I am very pleased to confirm that BSR have decided not to proceed with their application for the Solar Farm at Coombe. Whilst the use of renewable energy has much support this site, in the centre of Salisbury Plain and so close to Coombe residents was just not suitable. The following is an extract from their communication to us. I would like to thank the PC members and Terry Mundy for all their hard work regarding this application.

"Having carried out Public Consultations and listened to the community, considered the overall impact of the project and balanced it all against the uncertain future that the renewable energy industry faces (particularly near term), we believe that this project is no longer worth pursuing. We have therefore removed it from our pipeline and informed the Landlord of our decision.

I would therefore be grateful if you could also inform the community that BSR will no longer be exploring a solar renewable energy project on Revie House.

Fully accepting all the concern, upset and uncertainty that this potential project has caused, on behalf of BSR I would like to thank you and the local community for your patience and understanding.

We wish you all well for the future. With thanks. "



Patricia Elkington gave the Garden club a very informative and thought provoking talk on using white and silver leafed plants in the garden and how to maximise their use in relation to stronger colours. Surprisingly, white is a very dominant colour and can make a focus point not always wanted. Silver plants or shrubs can be used to soften planting, for example stachys, the lovely grey woolly leafed plant with bright coloured tulips. A good tip she gave was to use our cameras and then study the photos to see if plants should be moved or others added. A lovely slide she showed was of a huge sea of dandelion seed heads in Thenford Church yard swaying gently in the breeze but perhaps not an example we would all want to follow!!



A Team Vicar's Musings

You will all have heard by now that we didn't have any applications for the Team Rector post and as I am writing this we are waiting to meet with the Archdeacon to discuss what next. It may seem strange to those of you who are used to a post being filled very quickly, often before the current post holder has left. However, in the Church of England the current thinking is that there needs to be a break between each incumbent; partly because they have been living in the community and we need to become used to the change and partly because it is hard to write a profile, which includes a Job Description and Person Specification, whilst the current post holder is in situ.

At the same time we need to discern what God is wanting us to do and be in the Team. This again can take time and a willingness on our part to listen to God and accept what he is wanting from us. If this also includes the need to change then it can take even longer as many people don't like change and will fight it.

In all our lives we need to make decisions about the future, some of which are very hard to make for a variety of reasons. How do you make these decisions? Well I often have a piece of paper divided into two – one side saying 'for' and one saying 'against'. I then make lists under each one, sometimes it becomes very clear what I need to decide whilst at others it isn't that clear. I surround all my decision making with prayer, asking God to help me to discern what to do. This applies to decisions about me as a Team Vicar as well as me as a member of this community and of the UK, and there are various votes to be made in this month and June which need clear thinking.

However, you make your decisions can I ask that you hold the seven churches in the Avon River Team in your prayers whilst we decide what next? If you have any thoughts on the matter do let me know them.
