Temporary Closure of: A342 (Part) Andover Road, Upavon, Everleigh and Collingbourne Ducis (Ref: TTRO 4337)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

A342 (Part) Andover Road, Upavon, Everleigh and Collingbourne Ducis; from its junction with High Street, Upavon to its junction with A338, Collingbourne Ducis.

To enable: Wiltshire Council to carry out surface dressing and adjustment to ironworks.

Alternative route: Via A345 - A303 - A338 and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will come into operation on 16 July 2016 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required daily between the hours of 07:00 and 18:00 until 17 July 2016. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.

Enford Community Fund

A number of requests were considered by the committee at the March round of funding and the following awards were made:

The sum of £1000 was promised to the Parochial Church Council in support of their efforts to secure funds and make the necessary repairs to the church roof. The sum of up to £119 was awarded to the Newsletter to cover costs of their website. Finally the committee has promised a small amount to cover the costs of materials so that the river bridge in East Chisenbury can be repainted – a project proposed by Amanda Marx as a celebration of Her Majesty the Queen's 90^{th} Birthday.

The Enford Community Fund comprises all the profits from the fete and fireworks events and is there to help community projects within the Parish of Enford comprising Enford, East and West Chisenbury, Coombe, Compton, Fifield, Littlecot, Longstreet and New Town. So, if you run, or are considering setting up, a project which may require help with initial costs or equipment, please get in touch.

Applications for awards must be made to the treasurer – Amanda Farrow – by email or letter no later than the first day of the award month (March & September). amanda.farrow@chisenbury.co.uk or 537 East Chisenbury.

The following guidelines will be followed in allocating funds

- 1. Awards will be considered every 6 months in March and September
- 2. Awards will be made for individual projects and are not designed to allow awardees to become reliant on the award on an annual/regular basis
- Awards will be made to causes that benefit the community and not specific individuals
- 4. No awards will be made for greater than £1000
- For any award to be granted there must be agreement by at least 75% of the funding committee


