Roof Repairs ~ All Saints Church Enford

The Parochial Church Council (PCC) are very pleased to report that our second attempt to secure major funding for repairs to the North Aisle roof and to the Tower roof has been successful, thanks in no small part to the evidence that was provided to demonstrate the huge community effort to contribute to funding the Project. We have been awarded £76,700 by the Listed Places of Worship Roof Repair Fund which, with a VAT rebate of £17,400, the £1,000 grant from the Enford Community Fund, £2,000 from the Samuel William Farmer Trust, £2,000 from the Blanket Appeal, and £7,000 from Church funds provides sufficient funds (£106,100) to meet the estimated Project cost of £105,400.

A bat survey has been completed and work will start next year! A sincere thank you to all involved in this success.

1. Awards will be considered every 6 months in March and September
2. Awards will be made for individual projects and are not designed to allow awardees to become reliant on the award on an annual/Regular basis
3. Awards will be made to causes that benefit the community and not specific individuals
4. No awards will be made for greater than £1000

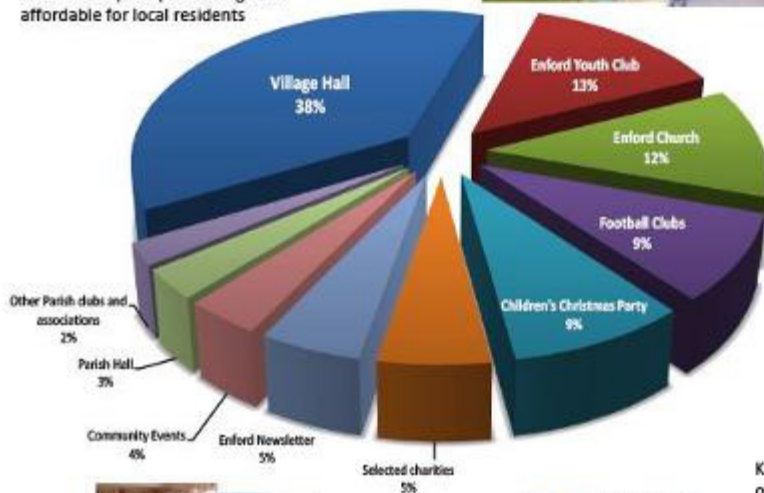
