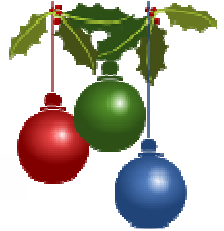

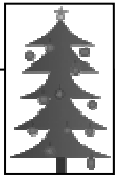

October Meeting: Geoff Hobson gave a very instructive talk on growing and caring for orchids indoors. It appears they are not so tender as a lot of people fear and really need minimum care once established. The main problems occur when over watered though interestingly they tolerate tap water; water them from above letting the water drain out and add orchid fertiliser every so often. They can be sprayed once or twice a week in warm weather to keep them flourishing and never stand them in full sunlight, also it is a good idea to wipe the leaves. Several members brought in their plants and Geoff was able to offer advice and tips on their maintenance and had many questions to answer. It was a very interesting evening.

November Meeting: The November meeting of the Garden Club had a very interesting talk on creating interest in a garden for all seasons. This did not just rely on flowers but covered shades of green, shapes, grouping shrubs, underplanting with bulbs for spring and summer and mixing colours together which caught the eye and even in winter produced interest. Sarah Gruzelier brought pieces of plants/shrubs and then showed slides of her own garden to show where they were growing in the garden through the whole year to

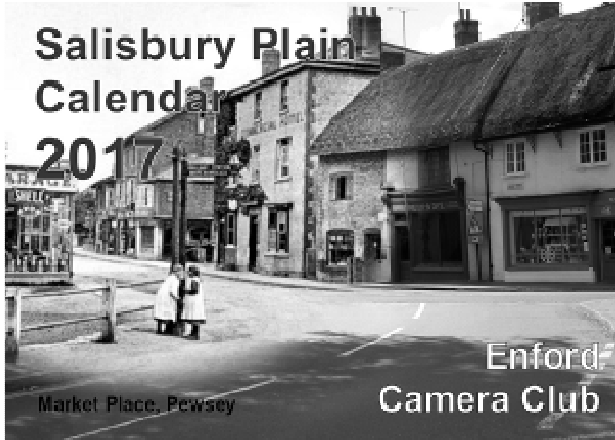

I am trying to earn money to go on a senior hockey tour with my school next year and so I would like to earn some money over the Christmas holidays and weekends generally.

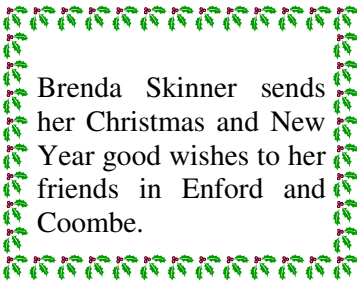

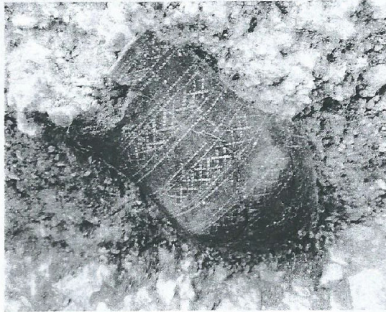

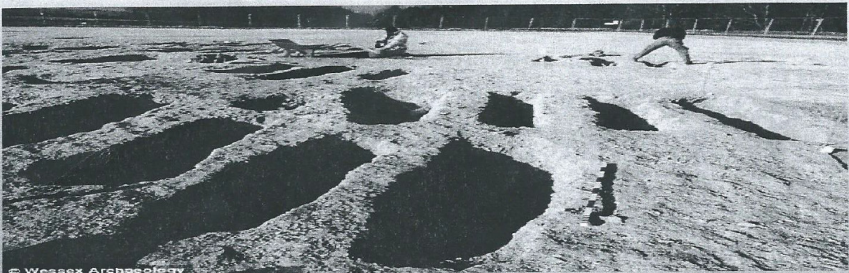

4. No awards will be made for greater than £1000
5. For any award to be granted there must be agreement by at least 75% of the funding committee

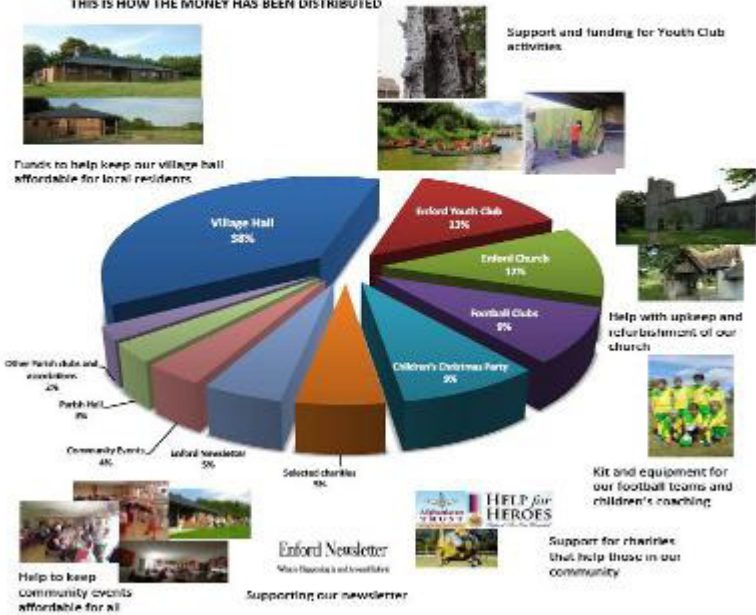
