A Team Vicar's Musings

This is the last 'Musings' that I will write as I retire on March 12th at the Team Service in Durrington (11.00a.m.), which will also be the first one for Phillip our new Team Rector. I started worshipping in these villages in 1986, firstly in Bulford, then the Avon Valley Benefice, then the Avon River Team. However, whilst I was training to be a priest I moved to worship in Durrington for a while so lost touch with the other villages until we all joined up about 5 years ago.

So it now comes to an end for at least six months as I need to spend time away from the Avon River Team getting used to the idea that I am no longer a Team Vicar. During these months I will experience worship in different churches waiting on God to understand what he wants me to do next. I have described it as being in a punt without a punt pole, drifting with the current stopping wherever the current takes me. Or as Hildegarde of Bingen puts it 'a feather on the breath of God', wherever God blows I will go.

Thank you and The Lord bless you and watch over you, the Lord make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you, the Lord look kindly on you and give you peace.

Enford Gardening Club February Meeting Report by Lowenna Harbottle Roses

Stewart Pocock gave a superb talk with demonstration and slides on the planting, growing and pruning of roses. We were told roses will grow in any soil providing it is not waterlogged. Bare root plants bought are preferable, they will thrive well. Container grown plants take much longer to establish. Plant with plenty of organic compost and plant above the root stock. This will encourage new, healthy rose stems.

If you do decide to plant container grown roses, remove from the pot and plant as they are; do not tease out the roots. If they are to be transplanted into a garden container, use John Innes no3 compost plus a slow release fertiliser. Stewart suggested you can feed roses using "Top Rose" from 1st March with a second feed after the first flush of flowers. With alkaline soil you can feed monthly to the end of July or you can use Uncle Tom's Rose Tonic, if you prefer.

Roses like to be hard pruned in February although not when the weather freezes day and night. Roses dislike being watered in hot weather, it encourages disease. Water in the early morning only when absolutely necessary.

To deter black spot spores provide a thick, wide mulch of organic compost around the base of all roses. Do not use bark chippings. If you do have black spot you can spray with "Uncle Tom's Plant Tonic". Good luck with this! Black spot is notoriously difficult to get rid of completely.

We were given a huge amount of information and had many questions answered. It was a very interesting thoroughly enjoyable and inspiring evening. Enford roses should do well.

Wednesday Night is Exercise Night at Enford Village Hall

We are a friendly group meeting from 6.15 – 7.15 pm each Wednesday evening. We exercise for an hour using a variety of equipment including small fitballs, hula hoops, resistance bands and light handweights. Some of the class is done standing, some seated on chairs and a small amount on the floor.

The programme is tailored to individual needs and everyone is encouraged to work at their own level. Ages range from 20s to 60s and the class is suitable for beginners as well as more advanced exercisers.

We do different things each week so you can join at any time. Equipment is provided but please bring a mat or towel for floor work. You pay as you go and the charge is £3.50 per class.
