## A word from Philip Bromiley our Team Rector: Giving time to Remember.

It was while sitting on the cliffs between Pentire Point and The Rumps in north Cornwall, UK, that Laurence Binyon first penned a poem that famously includes the Ode to Remembrance:

They shall not grow old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning, We will remember them.

A stone plaque erected in 2001 rests there to this day.

I always find it hugely moving to witness people gather to give an hour of our year to remember and honour those who were sacrificed in War. Jesus said, "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." Jesus not only said those words, but he applied those words to Himself and put them into practice. He too knew the reality and true cost of sacrifice.

I suppose the theological difference between the sacrifice of Jesus and the sacrifice of those in Conflicts is this: Jesus' sacrifice was universal. He laid down his life, so that we might live eternally, and be free from the consequences of sin. A Service man or woman's sacrifice is particular. They lay down their lives, so that we might live in freedom in the here and now.

Both expressions of Sacrifice proclaim the same truth that life and freedom are precious. Each year, as Remembrance Sunday comes along, it is as if it sharply taps us on the shoulder and says, "don't forget. For your tomorrow, we gave our today". So do join us for our commemorations on Remembrance Sunday.

#### Household Recycling Centre Refurbishment Programme and Closure Dates

Refurbishment Programme and Closure Dates FCC Environment start managing the operation of the recycling centres on 2 October 2017. Between October and December 2017 all Wiltshire Council owned household recycling centres (all sites apart from Purton and Lower Compton) will be closed for between one and two weeks in order for the sites to be refurbished and completely transferred to FCC Environment.

The refurbishment programme and closure dates are shown in the table below. This programme is being undertaken at the quietest time of year for the sites and aims to ensure that residents have access to another site locally therefore reducing the disruption as much as possible.

Apart from during the closure period for refurbishment, all sites will be operating the normal opening days and hours. We will therefore be actively encouraging residents to check the website to see which local sites are available before they travel.

### ENFORD PARISH COUNCIL EXCERPTS FROM

Draft Minutes of the meeting of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2017 held in the Village Hall.

#### 17/103 Public Questions

Dorothea Georgeson (Chairman of the board of Netheravon All Saints Academy Trust) explained that the school had 198 children at present, 11 of whom came from Enford. She felt there should be a stronger connection between Enford and the school. Their biggest priority is to increase the numbers. Cllr Roberts suggested a discussion on this at the next meeting.

Alan Day, Community Speedwatch, had been sent the quotations for a Speed Indictor Device (SID). It was generally agreed that this would be a beneficial purchase for the village. Cllr Exley made the point that seeing people in jackets is a better speed deterrent than a sign which becomes familiar and gets ignored. The result being that Cllrs. D'Arcy-Irvine and Roberts would work with Alan Day to provide a fully costed report on acquiring a SID for Enford which would be presented at the next meeting.

#### 17/104 Police Matters & Neighbourhood Watch

Maria Downham had sent in the Community Policing Team report which stated that there had been no incidents recently reported for Enford. Cllr Exley, representing Neighbourhood Watch said she had come across the Bobby Van Trust and explained how it helped the vulnerable with home and internet security among other things through seminars, home visits etc. All their work is done free of charge but they would expect a donation. She thought the Village Hall might be a good location and Cllr Cliffe-Roberts suggested inviting them to The Hub on a Thursday morning. Cllr Exley will contact the newsletter team to try and raise awareness and fix a date.

#### 17/105 MOD/ Army Matters

WO2 Tony Broadbent sent a report.

**Future training on SPTA:** 8-26 Nov: 1 Scots Guards battle group are on Ex Wessex Storm supported by a German Battalion which will involve a fair amount of heavy armoured vehicles.

#### 17/106 Unitary Council Matters

Wiltshire/ Unitary Councillor, Ian Blair-Pilling raised a few matters.

1. There are two consultations he wanted to raise awareness of:
Firstly: Waste Management – whilst the Wiltshire Council contract has been taken over by FFC and Everleigh has been included in the new contract system, the site has been operated with the wrong drainage system for some time. To put things right it will cost extra money and W. Council are looking into the costs of doing this. Should these become too much the site will again be in danger of being closed down. He urged all Cllrs (and friends, family etc) to go to the Wiltshire Council website and do the survey available. The more respondents, the better chance there is of keeping the site open.

Secondly: the re-routing of HGVs around the Tidworth, Collingbourne Ducis, Lugershall area which does not impact Enford however the meeting will be in Netheravon on 4<sup>th</sup> November at 6 o'clock. He would like to see as many members of the public present as possible to find out the details and make their views known

2. <u>Superfast broadband</u>. Claire Perry MP led an event looking at the superfast broadband roll-out across Wiltshire. BT say the coverage in Wiltshire is 91% and they are working on the more rural areas.

#### 17/109 Matters Arising

#### ii. The Donation of £100 to Enford's Roads/Highways

The Tidworth Area Transport Group has offered to 'match fund' this bringing the total to £200. Cllr Hiskett said that Pete and Emma at the Swan were going to ask the Parish Council to erect a sign asking their customers to park with consideration for the village. The Council unanimously agreed to use these funds to purchase a sign. The Parish Council will organise the sign. iii. The Parish Hall

Cllr Exley had reviewed the Parish Hall situation from a legal perspective, but made the point that this was not her area of expertise. She had emailed Richard Petitt and the other members of the Parish Hall Management Committee explaining that they remain liable for the Hall (notwithstanding the joint letter of resignation) until such time as they call and AGM to formally stand down following the specified 14 day notice period. At the time of the PC Meeting there had been no response to her second email. It was agreed that the PC Clerk would contact the Parish Hall Treasurer to remind him that the Hall insurance expires in November and the current Committee remain personally liable in the event of uninsured losses.

#### iv. The Playpark, RoSPA Report

The overall report gave a medium risk to the area and equipment. Some repairs have already been made.

#### 17/112 Parish Plan - Youth Funding

Cllr D'Arcy-Irvine reported that funds raised currently stood at £1,033.15. He is still waiting to hear back from Wiltshire Council regarding the extra land to increase the Playpark area and create Allotments. He thought the whole project would cost in the order of £20,000.00

#### 17/113 Roads and Highways

Cllr Harbottle reported:

- 1. Both Water Lane and Coombe Lane have suffered tank damage. Whilst the Army has been informed, not all the damage has yet been repaired.
- 6. We are still waiting for SSE to deal with the Water Lane problem.

#### 17/114 Public Rights of Way (PRoWs)

Cllr Hiskett reported that as the PCCI representative on the Parish Council, he has been asked to raise awareness of a potential problem with groups of youths loitering around the lychgate. This involves smoking, drinking and possibly even drugs with the associated rubbish left behind. There is a similar problem around the Village Hall.

#### 17/115 Correspondence

Cllr Roberts mentioned the crashing of the Enford newsletter website. Thanks go to Clare Burge and Kim Riche for their hard work in solving the problem.
