Victoria and Abdul tells the touching story of the late life relationship between Queen Victoria and her Indian Muslim servant, Abdul Karim – known as the Munshi.

Karim was sent to Britain from India to present the Queen with a gold coin to mark her Golden Jubilee in 1887. He caught the Queen's eye and became an integral, if controversial, member of her staff and household.

The film stars Judi Dench as Queen Victoria, Ali Fazal as Abdul Karim, the late Tim Pigott-Smith, Eddie Izzard, Adeel Akhtar as well as Michael Gambon. It was lavishly filmed at Greenwich and at Osborne on the Isle of Wight, and was directed by the legendary Stephen Frears. The film was released in 2017.

Hugo Vickers will introduce the film. He was the historical adviser on the film, and also took part as an 'extra' in two scenes.

## *Recipe of the month*

### **HOT SMOKED SALMON SALAD WITH PEAR, AVOCADO AND HORSERADISH SAUCE**

4 hot smoked salmon fillets (fish section in supermarket or choose cooked from the chiller)

2 ripe avocados	1/2 red chilli, deseeded and chopped
100g radishes	zest & juice of 1 lime
1 small pot (125ml) creme fraiche	1 tsp hot horseradish
1 bag mixed salad leaves	1 sweet ripe pear
Handful of chopped walnuts	Olive oil and balsamic vinegar
Salt and pepper	

Slice the radishes and put into a bowl of cold water to crisp up.

Scoop the flesh out of the avocados and mash them roughly with the lime juice and zest. Season with the chilli and some salt and pepper. Cover tightly with clingfilm till needed.

Put the salmon fillets on a baking sheet and drizzle with a little oil. Put in a preheated oven to gas 6/200c for 8-10 mins uncooked, 5-7 mins if cooked).

Mix the horseradish into the creme fraiche and taste. Adjust seasoning, let it down with a little milk if too thick, you want it like cream.

Put the salad leaves onto a large pretty plate and season. Drizzle with just a little oil and balsamic and gently toss together.

Quarter and slice the pear thinly. Put in a little bowl with some water and lemon juice to stop it discolouring.

Break the warm salmon over the leaves and dollop the avocado in spoonfuls around.

Scatter the radishes and pear over, and top with the walnuts.

Drizzle with the horseradish and serve with crusty bread.

### **Cyclists raise over £30,000 completing Wiltshire to Devon challenge**

A group of cyclists travelled over 100 miles from Wiltshire to Devon to raise over £30,000 for the Stars Appeal, Salisbury District Hospital's Charity.

The Unlikely Cyclists completed the challenge over two days. William Warden, from Devizes, came up with the idea after his wife Sarah was diagnosed with breast cancer last year and cared for at the Stars Appeal funded Breast Unit. Friends were keen to support him, and Unlikely Cyclists formed.

The Stars Appeal aims to raise over £1million each year to fund projects offering direct, practical support to patients, their families, and the Hospital's staff.

The charity has provided the Hospital with additional CT and MRI scanners and a range of new facilities including an enhanced Children's Unit and Cardiac Suite.

Donations fund projects supporting cancer patients, including aromatherapy, headwear for patients who lose their hair, drinks for chemotherapy and oncology outpatients, and a programme offering support to patients preparing for surgery or treatment.

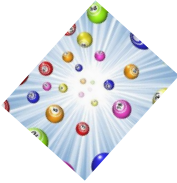

## Police and Crime Commissioner: Philip Wilkinson Have your say on rural crime!

In a rural county like Wiltshire, it's so important to keep on top of how Wiltshire Police are responding to and dealing with all forms of rural crime. Recently we've seen a few cases of fly-tipping and hare coursing which is just not acceptable.

Work is continuing to improve this as a police force, and I included it in the priorities set out in my Police and Crime Plan. I've also recently teamed up with the other five Police and Crime Commissioners from across the South West to launch the regional Rural Crime Survey.

As the voice of the public in policing, I am keen to better understand my constituents' views on these issues, their experiences of rural crime and what concerns them most. I also want to understand what improvements have been made since the National Rural Crime Network ran a similar survey in 2018, and what we still need to put more resource into.

In Wiltshire, our relatively small rural crime team deal with a broad range of crimes including all heritage and wildlife matters such as theft of livestock and machinery, fly tipping, poaching and hare coursing - to name just a few. Therefore, it's important we support their work with valuable and accurate data on what matters most to our residents.

I would be grateful if as many people in Wiltshire would participate in this survey as possible, no matter where in the county you live. By taking just a couple of minutes out of your day you will be helping me to understand how I can continue to make Wiltshire safer.
