3. TREASURER'S REPORT:

The accounts to 30 June 2019 show a deficit £1,535.75 mainly due to increased repair costs (partly as a result of previous vandalism) Last FY 2017-2018 there was a deficit £567.67. Income however was up which is encouraging. Active fund raising may need to be initiated. Kim Riche is kindly acting as Independent Auditor for the annual accounts ready for presentation to the AGM in September.

Nathan Abbott to start later on car park lights 23 Sep 2019 as having to dig trenches with damage to grass and area around car park would be detrimental to weddings and private parties already booked.

The directional Village Hall sign had been removed from the post at the junction near the bus shelter on the A345 which had led to several complaints from users trying to find Enford Village Hall. This has not been helped by the fact that the new sign just said 'Village centre' without specifying which village, and in fact appears to refer to East Chisenbury. Chairman had raised the matter with Highways as the Village Hall had funded the three village hall direction signs which had been designed, approved and installed by Highways ten years ago. The response had not been helpful but Chairman will continue to follow it up. Jane will ask the Parish Council to support the Village Hall's request to Highways to have the sign reinstated.
