

## **Wiltshire Council**

### **Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**Temporary Closure of: Various Byways and Bridleways, Enford and Upavon** (Ref: TTRO 5893)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all users:

- a) Byway 41, Enford; from its junction with Byway 40, Enford for a distance of approximately 740 metres in a southerly direction;
- b) Byway 40 (Part), Enford; from its junction with Byway 46, Enford to its junction with Bridleway 40, Enford;
- c) Byway 46, Enford; from its junction with Byway 40, Enford to its junction with Byway 45, Enford;
- d) Byway 45, Enford; from its junction with Byway 46, Enford to its junction with Byway 26, Upavon;
- e) Byway 26 (Part), Upavon; from its junction with Byway 45, Enford for a distance of approximately 140 metres in a northerly direction;
- f) Bridleway 19 (Part), Upavon; from its junction with Bridleway 40, Enford for a distance of approximately 190 metres in a northerly direction.

**To enable:** Filming and use of pyrotechnics.

**Alternative route:** via Byway 11 Upavon – Byway 26 Upavon – Byway 45 Enford – Byway 21 Enford and vice versa.

**The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.**

This Order will come into operation on 20 May 2019 and will be required until 07 June 2019. The Order will have a maximum duration of six months.
