My apologies for the delay in bringing you news on the Swan. Hannah will exit the pub on Monday 30 June. We have not been able to reach an agreement with her on purchase of any of the chattels that she has put in, some sort of follow-on trading and there is uncertainty over what state the pub will be in on Monday. We have potential plans to re-open the place as a predominantly wet-led temporary business, but it is impossible to be firm on timing and means until we get back in there. Similarly plans for a new tenant or longer term restructure are on hold until next week. More updates to come.

The following is a summary of a message distributed regarding the closure of the Swan. By the time of distribution, further updates should have been made available via social media.

## *Closure of The Swan, Enford.*

We are sorry to have to announce here the bad news that Hannah has closed her doors at the Swan on Sunday 22 June. This is deeply disappointing for her, the staff, customers and the village in general, and it is important to all of us what happens at the Swan.

### *What can be done?*

A big thank you to those who have asked to be added to The Swan, Enford Village WhatsApp group and to those who were able to attend the general meeting at the village hall on Friday 6th June your support and input is welcomed and appreciated.

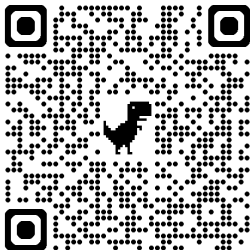
As outlined at the Village Hall meeting, there are two main activities being undertaken to protect and keep the Swan operational:

1. **Short Term** - keeping the pub open/limiting closure to a minimum
2. **Longer Term** - Ownership & Structure going forward

This feedback and questionnaire form is being provided as a first step to gain your input along with if you are able to physically support the operation of the Swan in the short term and whether you would be interested in financially supporting in the long term.

As said in the meeting, plans are in the formative stage and will evolve, so this is not definitive, nor last chance to be involved. This is especially true for the longer term ownership, so what this could look like cannot be definitively stated at this stage.
