What is Community Led Planning?



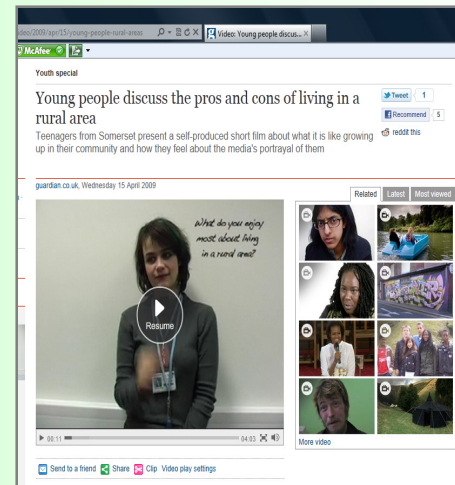
- A **plan** or strategy for the Parish – for the future of your community
- **Community led – YOUR plan!**
- Reflects the views of **ALL** sections of the community through effective community consultation



Parish or Town Plans



- Cover ALL issues of concern to local residents
- Non-statutory
- Influencing/evidencing documents
- c.25% Wiltshire towns/parishes have one



What are the benefits?



Parish Plans offer:

- Greater understanding of community needs and priorities
- An evidence base to support PC decisions and discussions with agencies, grant bids etc.
- A mandate for action
- Improved community engagement and input to local decision making

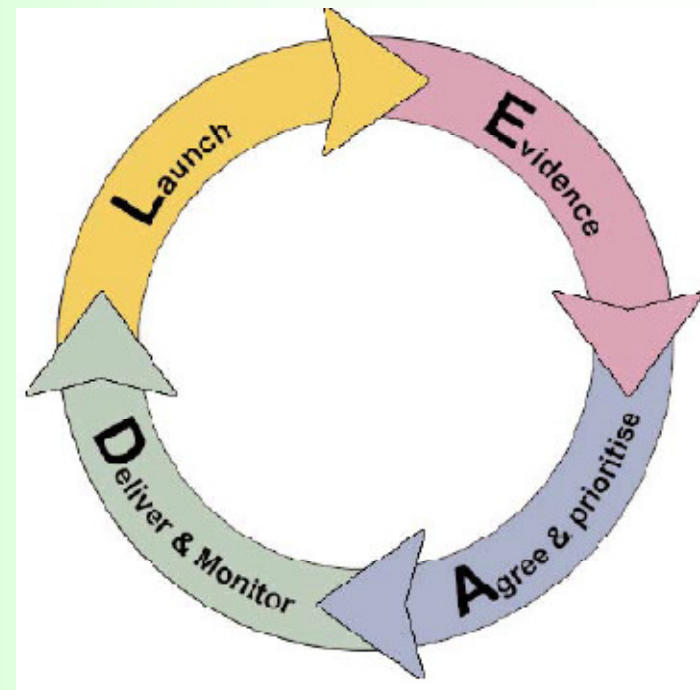


Preparing a community led plan

Identifying local needs and priorities for action



- Consultation with your community
- Talking with organisations and agencies whose work affects your community
- Research
 - on things that are significant or unique to your area
 - on how the community is changing
 - what is already being done to address issues that have been raised
