The committee felt that it was important that the parish plan contained some acknowledgement of the community's concerns regarding speeding and road safety— some additional suggestions included:	ALL

Traffic calming in Longstreet.	
 Improvements to the hill on the C32, to the south of Coombe. 	
No-one was quite sure how the PC might address this topic since, in order to construct a plan, it would first be necessary to establish feasibility – this could be a very lengthy process. Perhaps it would be more appropriate to draw up an agenda of issues and priorities which could be tackled as and when money and resources were available.
