- 2           **Declarations of Interest:** None
- 3           **Verify the Minutes of the last meeting:**  
The Minutes of the last meeting (27<sup>th</sup> February '12) were approved as a true record, proposed by Mr Michael Fay and seconded by Mr Adrian Orr.

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**Any Other Business**

Enford Bridge – new design:

The new bridge has raised questions of child safety and having heard from Mr Adrian Orr on the new design options that Wiltshire Council are prepared to put in place, it was agreed by all Councillors that the design of 4 stainless steel wires running through the lower two sections would be an attractive and efficient way to deal with the possibility of children falling through the framework.

Planning Application E/13/0253/4 – Old Bengers, Enford.

All Councillors considered the plans for the development at Old Bengers and concerns were raised as to the height of the new building. It was agreed that a site visit should take place and this has been set for Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April at 09.00hrs.
